ROBERT HIRSCH is an artist, curator, educator, historian and author of several works, including "Seizing the Light: A Social & Aesthetic History of Photography and "Light and Lens: Photography in the Digital Age." Hirsch has been an associate editor of "Photovision" and "Digital Camera," as well as a contributing writer for "Afterimage," "CEPA Journal," "World Book Encyclopedia" and numerous regional publications. Previously, he was a professor of photography at Amarillo College, University at Buffalo and SUNY Brockport, where he was also the director of graduate studies and associate director of the Visual Studies Workshop. Since 2000, Hirsch has led Light Research, a consulting firm providing professional services to the photographic arts field, and he has served on the board of directors of nonprofit organizations. He is the former executive director and chief curator of CEPA Gallery in Buffalo, New York, founder of Southern Light Gallery and co-founder of North Light Gallery. He has curated over 200 solo, group and public art exhibitions. His art has shown at galleries across the country.
